ALL WARNING AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE OF FORK TRUCK APPLY WHEN USING SELF DUMPING HOPPER

- 1. SECURE HOPPER TO FORKLIFT BEFORE USE
- 2. DO NOT OVERLOAD FORK TRUCK OR HOPPER, KNOW WEIGHT YOU ARE TRANSFERRING.
- 3. DO NOT STACK HOPPERS UNLESS EQUIPPED WITH STACKING FEATURE
 - A. DO NOT STACK HOPPERS WHEN FULL.
 - B. DO NOT STACK OVER 2 HIGH WHEN EMPTY.
- 4. NEVER USE HOPPER NEEDING REPAIR.
- 5. WHEN DUMPING FROM HEIGHTS USE ROD OR POLE TO ASSIST IN TRIPPING THE RELEASE HANDLE. NEVER CLIMB MAST OF TRUCK OR STAND ON BACK OF HOPPER BASE.
- 6. NEVER MANHANDLE HOPPER WHILE ELEVATED, IF THE HOPPER FAILS TO EMPTY COMPLETELY BRING DOWN AND FIND OUT WHY. LIGHT LOADS AND PARTIAL LOADS CAN BE DUMPED BY PUSHING THE BOTTOM WITH ROD OR POLE. STICKY LOADS MUST BE SCRAPED LOOSE WHILE HOPPER IS ON THE GROUND.
- 7. DO NOT DIRECT CHARGE FURNACES OR INCINERATORS.
- 8. MAKE SURE EVERYONE IS CLEAR BEFORE RELEASING TRIP LEVER.
